## **OICING THE PUCK O**


Icing the puck occurs when a player shoots the puck up the ice from his side of the center red line and across the opposing team's goal line and the puck is touched by an opposing player. When this happens play is stopped and a face-off is held in one of the face-off circles in the offending team's end of the rink. This rule does not apply to a team that is playing shorthanded due to a penalty or when the puck goes into the opponents goal.

### **OFFSIDE PASS**

An offside pass, also called a two-line offside, occurs when a member of the attacking team passes the puck up the ice across his own blue line and the center red line to a teammate. When this happens play is stopped and a face-off is held at the spot from which the pass was started.

## OFFSIDE

An offside occurs when any member of the attacking team crosses the defending team's blue line before the puck does. When this happens play is stopped and a face-off is held just outside the defending team's blue line in the neutral zone.



#### **Buccaneer Scouting System**

Scouting consists of several important situations. Most scouts will identify these to be the hunt, the find, the evaluation, the tryout and the gamble.

Tied together in working definition, scouting can be described as the search for hockey players with Junior "A" tools and gambling after he is found that his hockey skills will arrive at projected schedules. Most junior hockey clubs are interested in basically the same qualities when looking for a rare person. Generally speaking, these are the abilities to skate, shoot, handle the puck and use the body. The order of priority varies with each hockey club.

Measuring a player's tangible qualities is only half the battle. A player must also display the necessary intangible qualities such as desire, staying power, intelligence and a sound mental attitude. Without the intangible, physical hockey abilities are often neutralized.


When Buccaneer scouts are attending games, they are looking for the best hockey players between the ages of 16 and 19 years old. If a boy is invited to tryout camp, it is solely because his tools on a projected basis make the probability of him playing with the Buccaneers a distinct possibility.

If he advances quickly beyond that and remains with us for just a short time — that is part of the game.

The scout with many of his player recommendations in advanced leagues and colleges is a rare breed. He is also successful. I am proud to say that many of our scouts occupy that level.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the Buccaneer scouts for their efforts in helping me during this, the Buccaneer's fifth year.

On behalf of myself and my family, I would like like to thank the fans of the Des Moines and surrounding areas for their support during the past four years.


We have had many thrilling moments as well as some sad ones and you have supported myself and the players through each of them.

The copper plaque on display in the trophy case honors the memory of Bob Punsalan who for many years displayed the highest commitment and dedication to the young people of our Association.


