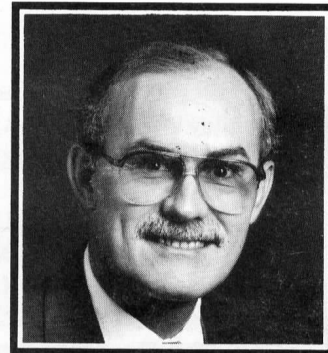
Welcome to another year of exciting Buccaneer Hockey!

It is my privilege, on behalf of the entire USHL, to welcome you to this evening's exhibition of the most exciting, hard-hitting, fast-moving, competitive sport in North America. USHL competition, tonight, here and throughout the League, and throughout the season, continues to be the best entertainment value in sports.

Last season continued the League's tradition of being "better than the season before." For the fifth year in a row, a USHL team was crowned National Junior "A" Champion in the United States, as the Rochester Mustangs captured their third National Championship in the last five years. The Thunder Bay Flyers continued to demonstrate USHL excellence on the other side of the border by competing in the playdowns for the Centennial Cup-- the Canadian National Junior "A" Championship.

Our true success, however, is measured in the advancement of the careers of our participants. Bob Ferguson joins the Buccaneers with a record of success...

Bob Ferguson is from Kingston, Ontario, where he grew up in a family that knows hockey success (his father, Lorne, was an 11-year veteran of the NHL.) Bob played Major Junior "A" for the Oshawa Generals and Cornwall Royals before being drafted by the New York Islanders.

After playing professional hockey for seven years he began his coaching career with the Sioux City Musketeers in 1980. During his nine seasons there, Bob's teams won two USHL Championships, two Playoff Championships and made four National Tournament appearances, culminating with the National Championship in 1986.

Bob has been named coach of the year three times, but he is most proud of the fact that over 150 of his players have advanced to play collegiate hockey.

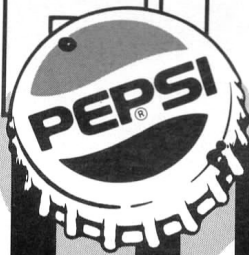
Coach Ferguson brings to the Des Moines Buccaneers a history of success and the knowledge of what it takes to develop players into solid collegiate hockey prospects.

Do you know your HOCKEY VOCABULARY?

Back Check (Legal) Attempts by the forwards on their way back to the their defensive zone to regain the puck from the opposition.

Boarding (Illegal) Violently forcing an opponent into the boards.

Body Check (Legal) Using hip or shoulder to slow or stop an opponent with the puck.

Breakaway The puck carrier getting ahead of all opponents except the goalkeeper.

Breakout When a team leaves their defensive zone with the puck.

Charging (Illegal) Taking 2 or more strides before checking an opponent.

Cross Checking (Illegal) Hitting an opponent with both hands on the stick and no part of the stick on the ice.

Drop Pass Puck carrier leaves the puck behind for a trailing teammate to pick up.

Fore Check Keeping opponents at their own end of the ice while attempting to regain the possession of the puck.

Freezing the Puck Holding the puck against the boards with stick or skates.

Hat Trick Three goals scored by one player in one game.

High Sticking (Illegal) Carrying the stick above shoulder level.

Headmanning Passing the puck forward to a teammate farther up the ice.

Interference (Illegal) Hindering or restraining a player not immediately involved in playing the puck.

Neutral Zone Center ice between the blue lines.

Penalty Box Area off ice where penalized players serve their "sentence".

Poke Check (Legal) Stabbing at the puck with the blade of the stick to try to take it away from the puck carrier.

Power Play While an opposing team is short handed due to penalty, the team with the man-power advantage send five men into the attacking zone.

Slap Shot Bringing the stick back and swinging it quickly forward, slapping the puck toward the goal.

Splitting The Defense Man with the puck goes between two defenders.

Wrist Shot Flicking the wrists to propel the puck off the blade of the stick.

Hockey's three main rules...

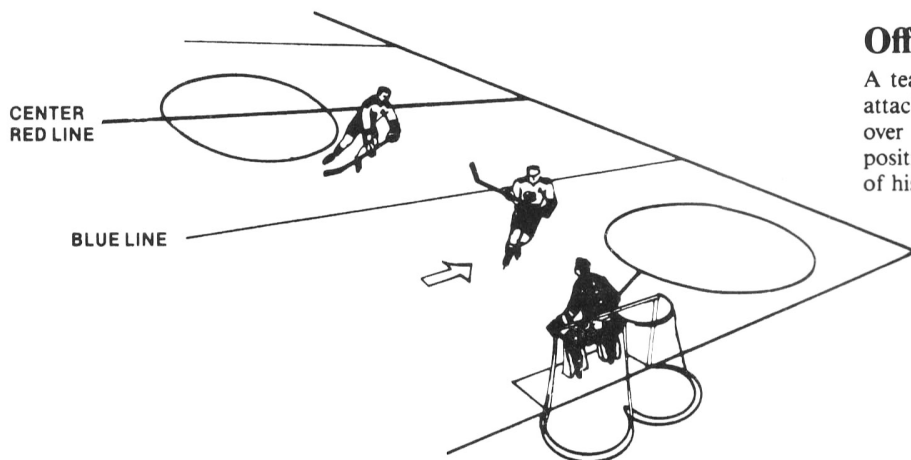
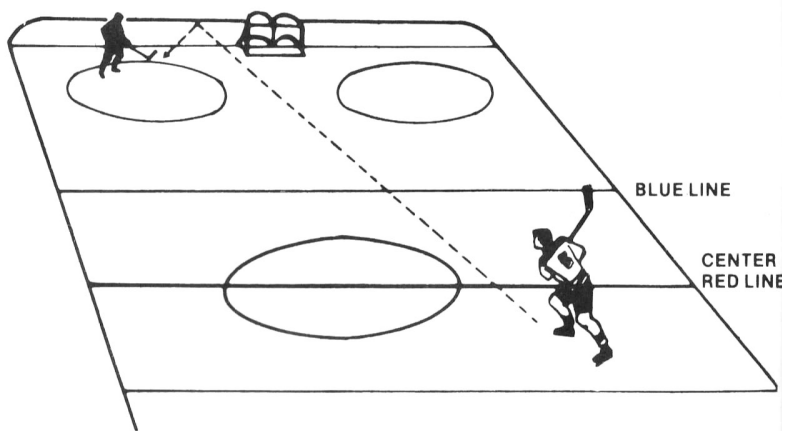
Learn these rules and you will know the cardinal principles of hockey.

Icing the puck

Icing occurs when a player on his team's side of the red center line shoots the puck all the way down the ice, it crosses the red goal line at any point other than the goal itself and is first touched by a defending player. When this occurs, play is stopped and the puck is returned to the other end of the ice for a face-off in the offending team's zone. In order to avoid icing, a player shooting the puck down past the goal line must be over the center red line when he releases his shot.

Icing the puck is not called if:

- a) the goalie plays the puck by leaving his net;
- b) if puck cuts across part of the goal crease;
- c) when a defending opponent, in the judgment of the linesman, could have played the puck before it crossed the red goal line;
- d) when an attacking player who was onside (in the same zone) when the puck was shot down the ice, manages to touch it first; and
- e) when a team is playing shorthanded because of a penalty or penalties.

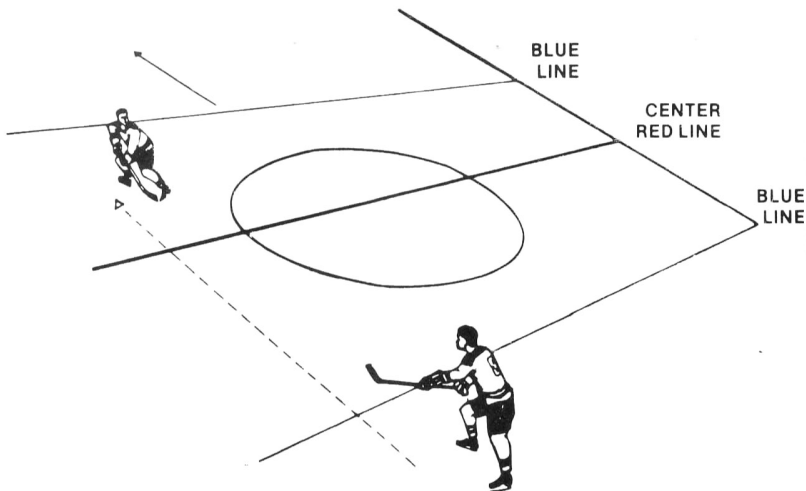


Offside

A team is offside when any member of the attacking team precedes the puck carrier over the defending team's blue line. The position of the player's skates and not that of his stick is the determining factor. If both skates are over the blue line before the puck, the player is offside. If he has only one skate over the blue line and one on it, he is onside.

Offside pass

When a player passes the puck from his defending zone to a teammate beyond the center red line (thus crossing the blue line and the red line) it is an offside pass. The position of the puck (not the player's skates in this case) is the determining factor in deciding from which zone the pass was made.

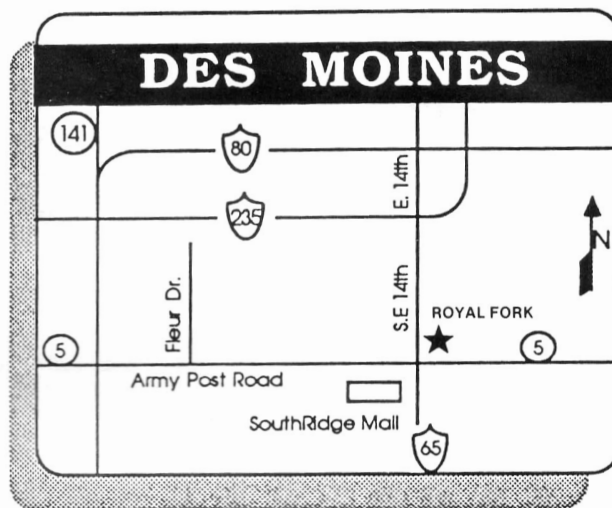

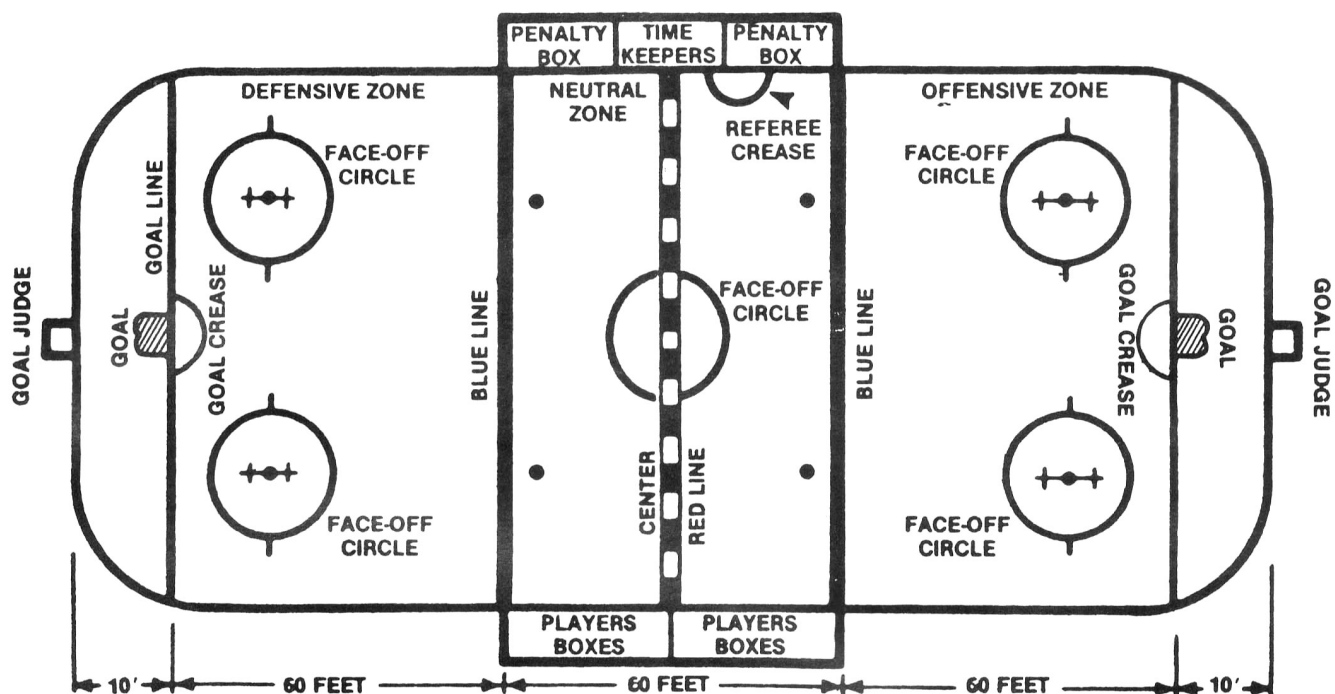

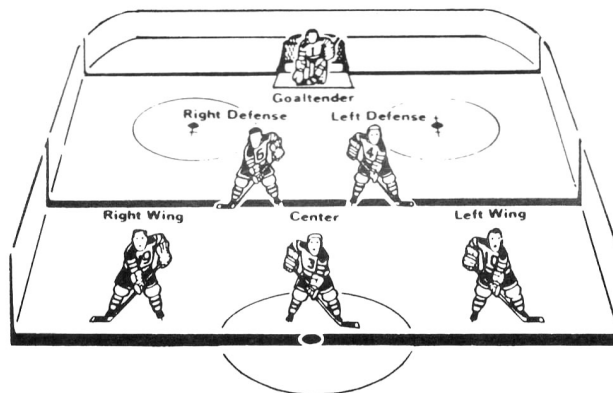

WHERE THE ACTION IS...



Six players on a hockey team...here's what they do:



GOALKEEPER — The goalkeeper's main responsibility is to keep the puck from entering the goal and there are no restrictions placed on the methods he can employ. His offensive contributions are limited and consist of occasionally passing the puck up to his defensemen or forwards to start a rush. A goalkeeper never scores a goal and only on rare occasions does he receive credit for an assist.

DEFENSEMEN — Basically the two defensemen try to stop the incoming play at their own blue line. They also block shots, clear the puck from in front of their goal and watch the opposing forwards. Offensively, they carry the puck up the ice or pass the puck up to the forwards, then follow the play into the attacking zone and help to keep it there.

CENTER — The center operates mostly up and down the middle of the ice and usually leads his team's attack by carrying the puck. He sets up plays by exchanging passes with his two wingmen and tries to steer the play in towards the opponent's goal. Defensively, he tries to keep the play in the attacking zone by harassing the opponent's puck out of their end of the rink, and tries to interrupt their playmaking as it moves through the neutral zone and into his defending zone (backchecking).

WINGS — The two wings move up and down the sides of the rink with the direction of play. Offensively, they skate abreast of the center, exchanging passes with him while positioning themselves for a shot at the goal. Defensively, they watch the opponents wings and try to disrupt their playmaking and shooting as the action moves back toward the defending zone (backchecking).

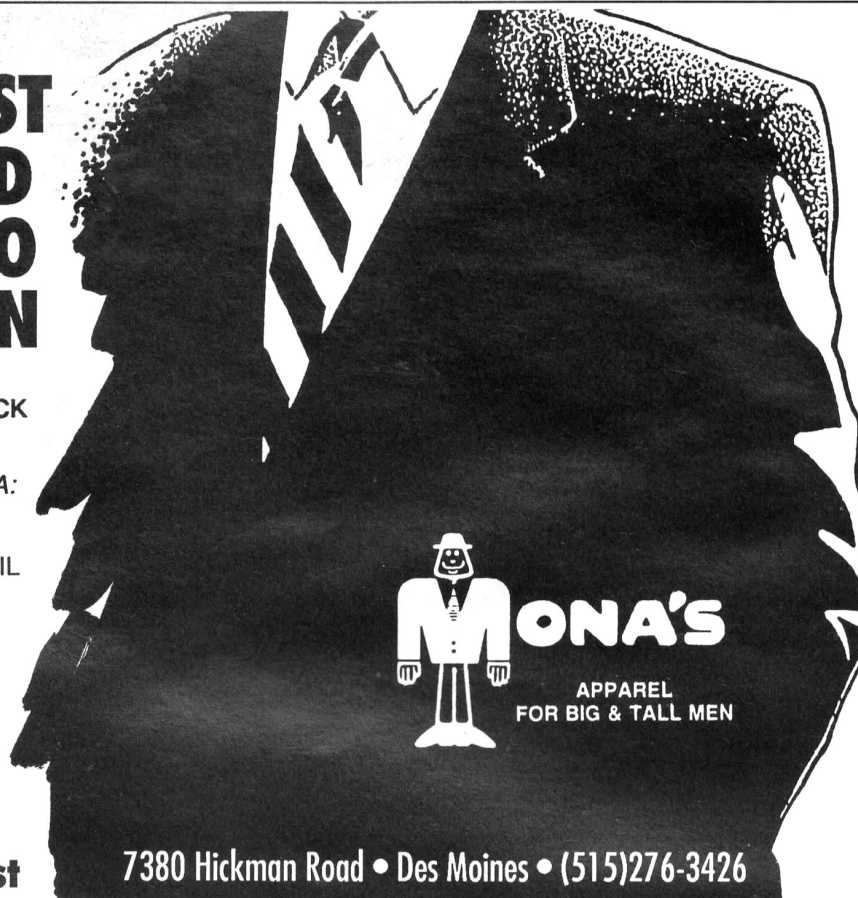

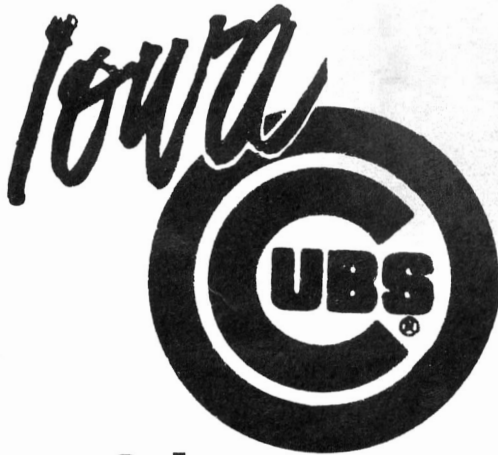

About the game / Referee's Signals. . .



BOARDING

Pounding the closed fist of one hand into the open palm of the other hand.



HOLDING

Clasping the wrists of the "whistle hand" well in front of the chest.



DELAYED CALLING OF PENALTY

Referee extends arm and points to penalized player.



CHARGING

Rotating clenched fists around one another in front of chest.



ELBOWING

Tapping the elbow of the "whistle hand" with the opposite hand.



HOOKING

A tugging motion with both arms, as if pulling something toward the stomach.



CROSS-CHECKING

A forward and backward motion with both fists clenched extending from the chest.



HIGH-STICKING

Holding both fists, clenched, one above the other at the side of the head.



ICING

Linesman's arms folded across the upper chest.



INTERFERENCE

Crossed arms stationary in front of chest with fists closed.



ROUGHING

A thrusting motion with the arm extending from the side.



TRIPPING

Strike the right leg with the right hand below the knee keeping both skates on the ice.



KNEEING

Slapping the knee with palm of hand while keeping both skates on the ice.



SLASHING

A chopping motion with the edge of one hand across the opposite forearm.



UNSPORTSMAN-LIKE CONDUCT

Use both hands to form a "T" in front of the chest.



MISCONDUCT

Place both hands on hips.



SPEARING

A jabbing motion with both hands thrust out in front of the body.



WASH-OUT

Both arms swung laterally across the body with palms down. When used by the Referee it means goal disallowed.

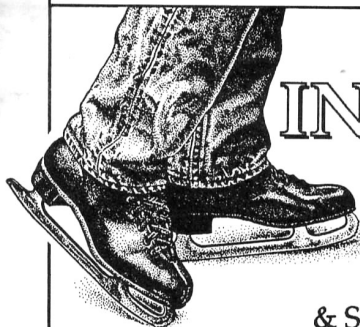

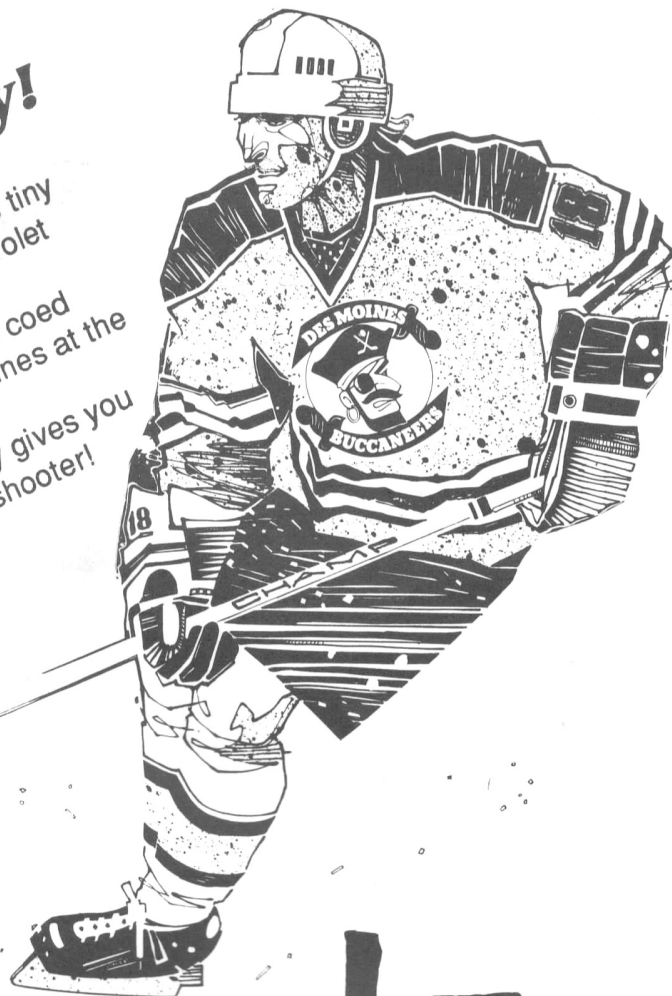

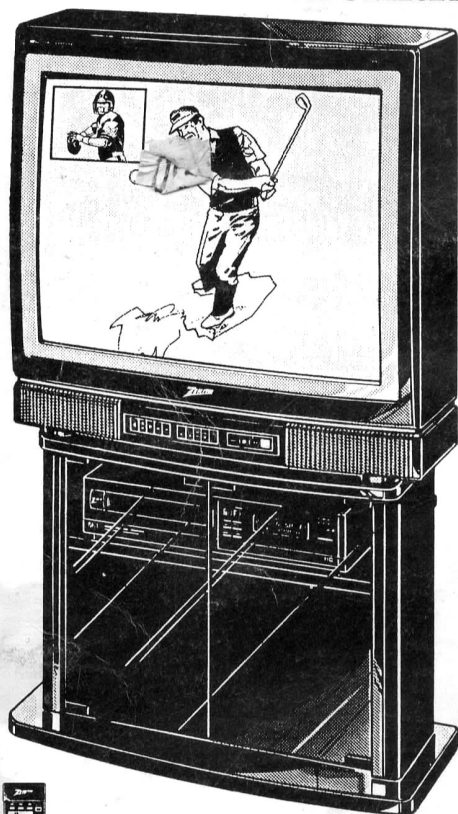
